



# Student Guide: Google Meet for Virtual Learning

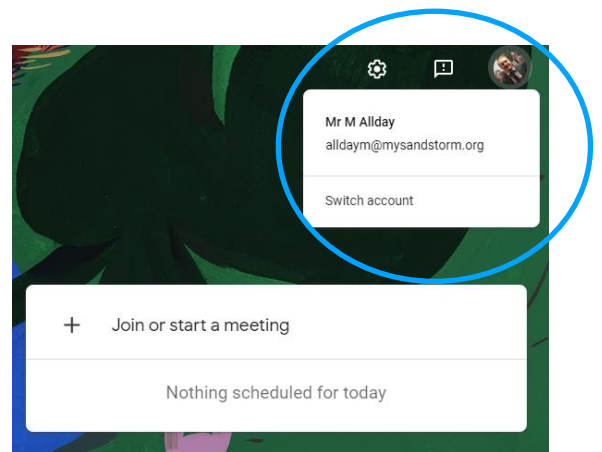


Google Meet is one of the apps that will be used to deliver remote learning if the school closes. It will work in the browser on your device (iPad / Android Tablet) however it will be much better if you download the app. Below are the QR codes that you can scan to download the apps for your device:



If your teacher is going to use Google Meet they will send you a link via Google Classroom. To join the lesson tap on the link and if you have the app installed it will take you to the app (otherwise it will load the lesson in the browser).

It is essential that you are signed into your **school MySandstorm account** when joining the Meet. Click the icon in the top right hand corner on the joining back to check which account you are sign in to, and switch if required (see image to the right):



## Key things to remember when joining a Google Meet

1. Only join the meet at lesson time promptly and make sure you leave at the end.
2. Before tapping 'Join now' make sure your video and audio are **turned off**, see image below.
3. **Video must remain switched off for the whole lesson.**
4. To join the lesson tap 'join now' instead of 'present'.
5. **Only use the chat function if you are asked to do so.**
6. **Only unmute your audio if you are asked to do so.**
