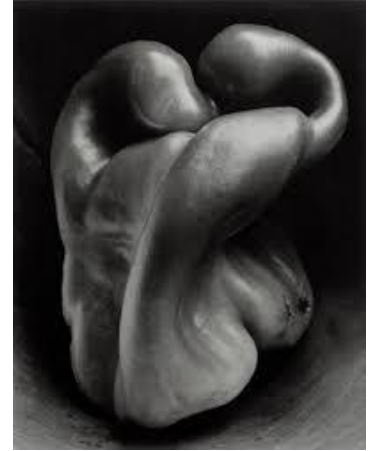


Photography- A level Summer Project- Light and Shade

In photography, it is vital to pay attention to light in order to capture strong photographic images. Light forms the basis of all photography so for your summer project, we would like you to begin to consider light in order to develop your visual recording skills.

Over the summer you will begin important preparation for your A Level course, it is vital that ALL tasks are completed to the best of your ability.

- Produce a PP and use it to collect a range of images that relate to the theme (Light and Shade). Please see the images on this sheet as a starting point. Collect images that have an interesting use of both light and shade but ensure that you collect a range of images that you find interesting and might be a good starting point for your own areas of interest.
- Complete a series of photoshoots based upon the theme 'Light and Shade'. Look carefully for opportunities around your home that you could capture photographically.
