Consultation on Admissions - September 2022 intake **2nd November 2020 - 14th December 2020**

We are consulting on a change to our admission arrangements from September 2022 - August 2023.

These changes are to accommodate advice from Hertfordshire County Council on multiple births applications and clarification on the processing of applications for children seeking admission outside their chronological year group.

The local governing board of Sandringham School have considered this proposal at length and in consultation with HCC have formulated a new admissions criteria for operation from September 2022. A copy of the proposed criteria is attached with this letter for your consideration during the consultation period.

The key changes to our admissions criteria are:-

- 1) Twins/multiple births: Sandringham, as the admission authority, will admit over the school's published admission number when a single/twin/multiple birth child is allocated a place at the school.
- 2) Summer born delayed entry to reception: If a family has delayed entry to reception by one year for a summer born child, this child will be admitted to Year 7 following completion of their primary schooling, subject to the application being processed by HCC in accordance with the admissions criteria.

We welcome your comments prior to the close of consultation so that our decision fully embraces the wishes of the local community. Should you wish to response to his consultation, please do so in writing to Mrs. Lesley Dunkley, Clerk to the Local Governing Board by 9.00am on Monday, 14th December 2020. We will not be able to acknowledge or respond individually to your comments, but they will be taken into account.



At the end of the period of consultation, the Governors Admissions Committee will meet to consider any response and prepare a report and recommendation to the Full Local Governing Board who will determine the admissions criteria for September 2022 - August 2023 by 28th February 2021.


