General entry requirements

History

All three BeauSandVer Trust schools are comprehensive and admit a wide ability range to their Sixth Forms. However, in general terms, we require applicants to have grade 6 or better in the subjects they wish to study, or their closest GCSE equivalent. In addition, students needs to have achieved a minimum average point score of 5+ if they wish to study A levels (excluding separate sciences), and average point score of 6+ if they wish to choose any A Level subjects, including separate sciences. For those students with an average point score of 4 - 4.99, students can choose three subjects which must include at least one BTEC or CTEC qualification.
