## Year 11 Celebration Events

Following on from my letter before the Easter holidays, I wanted to thank all who have purchased Yearbooks and Prom Tickets via ParentPay. I am also writing to provide an update on Hoodies and arrangements for the Year 11 Celebration Assembly.

### Year 11 Yearbooks

We will be placing the final order on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> May, so there is one final chance over the weekend to purchase a copy of the Yearbook on ParentPay. The cost is **£15** and payment must be received by **9.00am** on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> May** to secure your order. There will only be **one** print run.

### Year 11 Prom

The Year 11 Prom will take place on **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July**, subject to Government COVID-guidance. Tickets cost **£25** and the deadline for purchasing tickets on ParentPay is extended to **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May**.

### Leavers' Hoodie

We are now able to provide details of how you can order a Leavers "21" Hoodie. These cost **£20** and are available in adult sizes XS to XXL. When making your payment via ParentPay you will be prompted to add the hoodie size. The deadline for payment is **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> May**.

We are hopeful that we can secure delivery of Yearbooks and Hoodies in advance of the Year 11 Celebration Assembly. If this is not possible, then we will communicate details of how students can collect items from school in June.

### Year 11 Celebration Assembly

The Year 11 Celebration Assembly will take place on the morning of **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May** in The Sandpit Theatre. The assembly will start at 8.45am and students will leave site at approximately 10.30am.

I will be sending another message in the near future to provide further details about the arrangements for the assembly and to ask for your help in a **secret mission** to help make the assembly as enjoyable and memorable as possible for the students.



We want all students to enjoy their celebrations and, as such, it is important that we can have confidence that all students in attendance will participate positively and behave in a way that will not inhibit the enjoyment of others.
