## **A-level Geography Field Trip – Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2021 (Stratford Olympic Park) and Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021 (Walton-on-the-Naze)**

As part of the geography A-level course, it is compulsory for students to complete four days of fieldwork for their non-examined assessment (coursework investigation), which is worth 20% of their A-level grade. We are undertaking two day trips to **Stratford Olympic Park** and **Walton-on-the-Naze** during the summer term to provide students with the opportunity to practise data collection methods, and collect primary data for this purpose.

At Sandringham, we usually commit to a residential trip, but due to ongoing disruption because of the COVID-19 pandemic, alternative arrangements have been made this year, with teachers providing students with the knowledge and skills required to undertake primary (and secondary) data collection. This will include the provision of all required resources.
