### Year 7 Peak District Trip June 2021

We are delighted to offer the opportunity of a visit to the Peak District to our Year 7 students. We have reserved places for them at Ilam Youth Hostel, our usual choice of centre, and hope very much that all students will be able to enjoy this important part of their first year at Sandringham.

Due to the large numbers involved we travel in two separate groups as follows:

**7A, 7H, 7J, 7N - Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June to Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2021**

**7E, 7F, 7S, 7T - Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June to Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2021**

The trip involves an 8 mile walk in the famous Dovedale and we spend a day at Drayton Manor Theme Park.

The total cost of the trip is £159.50, which includes a voluntary contribution towards transport and entrance to Drayton Manor and a charge for board and lodging, and a trip t-shirt. If insufficient students are prepared to pay the voluntary contribution, then the trip may have to be cancelled for all students. As Covid restrictions have only recently been lifted unfortunately the schedule for payment is no later than Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2021. This will ensure that we are able to secure our places with the youth hostel and we can organise our groups before departure dates.
