## Summer School - 2021

The purpose of Summer Starters' 'Summer School' was to provide transition support and enrichment opportunities to the Year 7 cohort of students joining Sandringham School in September 2021.

Eligibility for Summer Starters was available to all students who had reached the end of their primary education and due to start at Sandringham in September 2021.

The offer of a fully funded place for 5 days per student was made to the parents of all eligible students and offered to all, irrespective of their academic and socio-economic background. In total 189 students participated in the programme. Summer Starters was funded through the ESFA/DfE Coronavirus (COVID-19) Summer School Programme Funding and was run over 2 weeks; each child was offered a weeklong provision, taking place between 9<sup>th</sup> August and 20<sup>th</sup> August.

The programme was staffed solely by Sandringham School Teaching/Support Staff. The programme was designed to offer a balance of academic and enrichment sessions, as well as team building opportunities, to support our students' immersion into Sandringham culture, reducing apprehension, and instilling a sense of comradery and community.

The school was allocated £59,401 in funding and a total of £59,396 was spent.

Staffing costs: £44,730 (40 staff members)

Materials and sundries: £9,970 (including T-shirts, medals, materials used, etc)

Catering: £4,700

We had overwhelmingly positive feedback from our students and their carers. Below you can see some of the messages that were sent prior to the programme's completion:
