Dear Parent / Carer,

I'm writing to you regarding the ESFA U18B final at Stoke City on Monday 9th May as your son has been a part of the squad this season. I have attached a letter to you as parents from the ESFA outlining the process for obtaining tickets (free) and arrangements. The KO for our game is 15.30 and we are currently putting arrangements in place to take a group of student supporters along with us. I am sure some of you are keen to travel yourselves to also watch and it would be great to see you there. We are yet to select the team but as your child has been part of the squad this year they are obviously being considered for selection, which we should make next Friday. Obviously the whole squad will travel, however as per competition rules we can only have 16 players on match day on the bench.

All spectators, aged 18 and over, will need to book a ticket to access the stadium on the day. The utility for spectators to book tickets online is now available and can be done so by visiting the ESFA Events page of our website. Once you visit the link, you will need to scroll down the web page and select tickets for the event you wish to attend. **Entry is free of charge, but tickets will be required on the day to gain access into the stadium. The deadline for booking tickets online is Friday 6th May.** You are welcome to pass this information onto family and friends so that they can book tickets directly.

The address of the venue is:

Stoke City FC Stadium, Stanley Matthews Way, Stoke-on-Trent ST4 4EG

Spectators will park in the West 2 Car Park and access the stadium via turnstiles located in the North Stand. There is no cost to park in the stadium car park.

There will be a refreshments kiosk available for spectators to purchase food and drinks. Souvenir programmes can be purchased at £1 per copy and will be payable by cash only. Toilet facilities will be available at the stadium.

Additionally, we would like the students to have some playing shirts that mark the occasion and continue to look for sponsorship for a set, however currently we are asking if you could contribute £20 per student to the cost of this so that we can have a new set of playing shirts with the game detailed on for this match.
