Year 12 Study and Work Experience Visit to Quickborn, Germany

Dates: 1st – 8th March 2023

I have pleasure in inviting your child to participate in our second study visit for Year 12 students of German to Quickborn, near Hamburg. Sandringham School already enjoys a very successful partnership with the Dietrich-Bonhoeffer Gymnasium in Quickborn because of the school's German Exchange for our younger students. We would like to use this link to support our A level German students in the development of their language skills.

Here are details of this proposed youth project:

Travel: Flight to and from Hamburg/Gatwick. Transfer by host families to Quickborn.

Accommodation: Accommodation will be with host families from the school who will also support students in language immersion.

Activities: Year 12 will spend the time in the school attending some lessons delivered by the German teachers relating to their A level course as well as participate in excursions with the German exchange group. Evenings will be spent with the host family.

Cost: This has not been finalised but should be about £250 depending on final overall costs. **Please make a deposit payment of £150 via ParentPay** as we will be purchasing the flights in the next two weeks. In addition, I am in the process of applying for a bursary of £1000 for this project from the UK-German connection organisation. Should our application be successful, I will use money to help fund this project.

Study commitments: As well as formal German lessons on A-level topics, students will also be required to complete a detailed journal in German recording their experiences and impressions.
