


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Exams and Academic support

OVERVIEW OF KS4 COURSE INFORMATION

All the GCSEs that your child are studying are the reformed 9-1 graded exams.

- 9 1 grading scale
- Linear GCSE exams (i.e. no modules)
- Terminal assessment (all GCSE exams at end of Y11)
- Single Tier exams (some subjects have Higher / Foundation)
- Exams will be sat in May/June 2023
- Vocational Courses may have some modular exams

KEY STAGE 4 OVERVIEW

At Sandringham, we offer a broad curriculum at Key Stage 4 with a wide choice of academic, creative and vocational courses. All students follow a 'core' curriculum consisting of Mathematics, English, Science, PE and Personal Development (RE/RSHE.) Within the compulsory core, students' timetables are further personalised by being entered for Combined or Triple Science, and by being entered for BTEC or GCSE Dance or PE.



ACADEMIC SUPPORT

- Regular assessment and reporting
- Lesson materials and home learning through Google classroom
- Trial exams in April 2023
- Sessions focussing on knowledge retention and study skills strategies through ELDs
- Home Learning Club

Specific interventions including one to one support, class revision sessions and mentoring all take place in the lead up to final examinations.

Year 10 Work Experience

Work experience

This is a really important experience for all students in Year 10.

It is a compulsory part of the Personal Development curriculum.

It is a 5 day placement between **19th - 23rd June 2023**.

<u>A letter explaining the basics about work experience was</u> sent to all parents/ carers today.

Placements

An excellent opportunity for students to engage in work, build their skills and confidence and consider their personal career pathway.

All students will take responsibility to find a placement either privately or through those provided by our partner, Services for Young People, on their online database Link2+.

Placements on Link2+ will go live in January 2023. Please note that placements provided on Link2+ can be rather limited both in number and breadth of industry sector. Placements are allocated automatically via the system, so students are not guaranteed their first choice and occasionally are not allocated any of their choices.

Therefore, in the first instance, we would strongly encourage students to source their own private placement.

Placements

We would like to encourage students and parents/ carers to start looking for a private placement **now**, so that there is plenty of time to organise something appropriate.

We will ask for the details from January 2023 and will need:

Company name, name of supervising employer, confirmation that the placement has public liability insurance.

We will send out all of the details about work experience in January with extensive guidance.
