### Understanding the report:

In this report, subject teachers will provide a grade for '**Current Attainment**'.

In addition, subject teachers will provide an assessment of each student's performance against our three Core Competencies. An explanation of each is given below.

- **Attitude to Learning (AtL)** - An assessment of this student's attitude towards - and engagement with - the subject. AtL grades will reflect a number of indicators including effort and application in lessons, verbal contributions, quality of written work, and focus and engagement.
- **Home Learning (HL)** - An assessment of the quality and consistency of this student's Home Learning, as well as the effort the student is exerting.



- **Organisation and Deadlines (Org)** - An assessment of this student's organisation (including equipment) and their consistency in meeting Home Learning deadlines.

For each of the above, students will receive a grade from **1 (Excellent) to 4 (Cause for Concern)**.
