Dear Parent/Carers,

Psychology Trip to the Freud Museum on Tuesday 27th June 2023

We have booked entry and two learning sessions with an education officer to the Freud Museum in Hampstead, London. As part of the visit students will experience an introduction to Sigmund Freud's life and work as well as consolidating key aspects of the Psychodynamic approach. The two workshops are titled "The curious case of Little Hans" and "Freud on Schizophrenia". This content links directly to the 'Approaches' topic in Paper 2 of the AQA psychology examination.

The cost of entry to the museum including the two education sessions is £15 and can be paid via ParentPay. We have secured 40 places but if the number of students applying exceeds the trip's capacity, names will be drawn at random to allocate places.

We plan to meet at **St. Albans City train station at 9am on Tuesday 27th July** to buy a return ticket to West Hampstead Thameslink. We will assist students to purchase these tickets in groups of three to reduce the price. The estimated cost of each ticket is currently **£10** on the day. Students can pay by cash or card for these tickets.

We plan to take the **9.31am train to West Hampstead Thameslink**, where we will complete a short walk (approx. 15 mins) to our destination Maresfield Gardens and arrive at 10:15am.

The event is expected to last for 3 hours. Students are advised to bring a packed lunch to eat after the museum tour and we plan to eat our lunch together in the museum garden.

We aim to be on board the **2:29pm return train from West Hampstead Thameslink to St. Albans at 2:41pm** and students will need to arrange for collection or make their way home from the train station. All students are expected to return together under the duty of care of the staff. Train times and timetables are subject to change and we recommend that students text or message you on the day to notify you of any delays/changes.
