Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 7 Enrichment Week – 19th – 23rd June 2023

I am writing to you about this year's Enrichment Week for year 7. Enrichment week provides students with an opportunity to immerse themselves in activities beyond the taught curriculum. We design our offer to include a range of opportunities for students to build relationships with one another and develop their team working skills.

All year 7 students will be **in school** on Monday 19th and Tuesday 20th June and will take part in the following activities.

Day	Activity
Monday	Variety of team building activities taking place outside. Run by an external company
Tuesday	Workshop sessions - making our students confident communicators. Run by an external company

The cost of these two activities is **£29**.

From Wednesday 21st to Friday 23rd June some students will be taking place on the residential trip to Buschcraft. Further information about this will be provided at the trip information evening taking place on **Thursday 25th May at 6:30pm in the Main Hall**.

For students who are **not** on the residential trip, the outline of the remainder of the week is below:

Day	Activity
Wednesday	Choice of E Week Activities which run over one or two days
Thursday	Choice of E Week Activities which run over one or two days
Friday	Day trip to Thorpe Park

You will find attached a booklet detailing the activities running on **Wednesday and Thursday**. Please note that some activities only run on one of the days and others could be a single activity which will run over both of the days. Within this booklet you will find the associated costs of each activity.

The cost of all activities is discounted by 50% for all families who are currently in receipt of free school meals or Pupil Premium funding. Parents/carers who wish to discuss financial assistance towards this contribution should contact the Finance Office.

Activities running on Wednesday and Thursday have limits on student number. In the event that an activity is oversubscribed we will allocate a place on another activity with available spaces.

Throughout Enrichment Week students are **not required** to wear their school uniform. We would ask that sensible clothing is worn each day depending on the activities which your child is participating in.
