Year 8 and 9 STEM and Futures Day at the Royal International Air Tattoo 2023

On Friday 14th July we have been given the opportunity to take a group of 60 students to the Royal International Air Tattoo held at RAF Fairford as part of their STEM and Futures Day program.

The day provides students with a chance to be motivated in their study of STEM subjects and to see the exciting career opportunities available in the dynamic sector of Aerospace. The air show will also be open to other visitors on this day, and so the normal flying and static display of the air show will be available for students to enjoy.

Students will be asked to meet no later than 6.45am, outside the SandPit Theatre, and will need to bring a packed lunch on the day, as lunch will not be provided. We will be leaving the air show at 2.30pm and therefore should return to school at approximately 5.00pm, traffic dependant. Students will be required to make appropriate arrangements to get home safely at this time.

We have managed to secure all 60 student tickets free of charge. Therefore, the total cost of the trip is **£20.00**, which helps to cover the cost of coach transportation. If insufficient students are prepared to pay the voluntary contribution, then the trip may have to be cancelled for all students. Please make payment by **Monday 19th June**, at the latest. **If this trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated by random lottery.** You and your child will be notified via email if they have secured a place on this trip. We hope that the day will be a very useful and an inspiring opportunity for our students.

Participation in this trip is subject to good conduct in school prior to the trip taking place. If any student's behaviour or attitude is in question and they are removed from the trip due to their conduct, any monies paid to date may not be refunded.
