- 1. Read A Doll's House, and research the writer: Henrik Ibsen, and the context in which he wrote

- 3. Read Frankenstein, and research the writer: Mary Shelley, and the context in which she wrote

- 5. Read *The Bloody Chamber and Other Stories*, and research the writer: Angela Carter, and the context in which she wrote
- 6. Read A Streetcar Named Desire by Tennessee Williams
- 7. Read Revolutionary Road by Richard Yates
