- Another French-speaking country

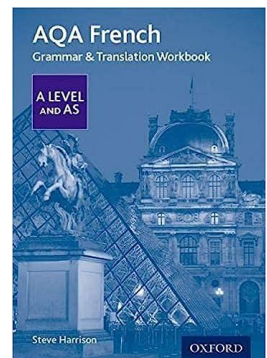
Your presentation should be no more than 5 minutes long and should, of course, be in French. It should also include a visual aspect, perhaps a PowerPoint, a poster or some photographs.
