We have booked entry to the Science Live! A-Level Physics conference at the Emmanuel Centre in London on Tuesday 21st November. As part of the visit students will listen to talks from world class scientists who are leading their fields, including the theoretical nuclear physicist, author and broadcaster, Jim Al-Khalili.
