Dear Families,

Year 12 Biology Field Trip 2024: Monday 6th May – Wednesday 8th May 2024

We would like to invite your child to a 3-day residential field trip to PGL at Osmington Bay, Dorset. As part of the Biology A-level, students are required to experience teaching and learning opportunities that involve regular practical work. A minimum of 12 required practical activities contribute to the practical endorsement element of the A-level qualification (graded as pass or fail) and will also be assessed through the written examinations. This means that they could be asked questions on them in either of the three written papers.

One of these required practical activities requires fieldwork to investigate the effect of environmental factors on species distribution. We have chosen PGL's Osmington Bay to conduct the fieldwork due to the coastal location providing investigation opportunities that include sand dunes and rocky shores.

The courses are run by staff at the centre that have experience of the AQA exam board specification requirements and knowledge of the locations in the area to carry out the investigations. In addition to the fieldwork, our group will have designated classrooms where they will be taught the necessary skills for processing their data and writing their reports.

The expectation will be that the fieldwork will be fully completed during the time away. The details for the trip are:

Location: PGL Osmington Bay, Dorset

Dates: Monday 6th May (Bank holiday) – Wednesday 8th May 2024

Departure: Approximately 8.00am

Return: Approximately 4.00pm

Transport: Return travel by coach, with the coach available for local transport for the duration of the stay.

Accommodation: Chalets accommodating up to 4 students in en-suite rooms.

The total cost of the trip is £305 which includes accommodation, meals and a voluntary contribution for travel. If insufficient students are prepared to pay the voluntary contribution, then the trip may have to be cancelled for all students.



The cost of the trip is payable in 2 instalments. The Deposit of £125 is due by 12th January 2024 and the final payment of £180 is due by 1st March 2024. Please make your payment via ParentPay. If your child is in receipt of the Year 12 bursary the trip will be covered by this.
