**Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) Parent Information Evening,
Wednesday 17th January 2024 – 6.30pm (Virtual)**

They have the most significant influence in enabling their children to grow and mature and to form healthy relationships. The Department for Education statutory RSE guidance states:
