Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award – Qualifying Expedition Blue Half: Friday 7th - Saturday 8th June 2024

The qualifying expedition for the **BLUE cohort** will take place in the **Hemel Hempstead** area, camping at **Hudnall Park Camp**. This is a common area for Award expeditions and is used by many local schools. Students will be walking a distance of approximately 12km each day over the two days, carrying their full pack and equipment and camping overnight. They will be expected to bring their own food for the two days.

Transport

Participants will be taken by coach to the starting point of their expedition. The coaches will be leaving school between 8.00am - 9.30am but your child will be told their exact departure time nearer the time of the expedition. We would ask that parents/carers collect students from the finish point on the second day. This is because groups will be arriving at staggered times and it is not possible to arrange group transport for them. We would anticipate that most groups should finish between 2.00pm – 3.00pm, but students will be able to ring you with a more exact finishing time. The finish point for the expedition is: Northchurch Common Car Park, Berkhamstead, HP4 1LS

Kit

Students have received a kit list as part of their training materials. This lists the items students should have with them for the expedition. Rucksacks/Stoves/Tents can be hired from school. Kit can be hired via ParentPay before the deadline of Friday 24 May. Students should arrange kit they can share between their groups.





















Supervision on expedition

An important part of the DofE experience is to be independent and self-reliant. As a DofE unit we have clear procedures in place to support groups through their expedition. Each group is provided with contact numbers for DofE mobile phones which they are permitted to ring should they encounter any difficulties. If this occurs, staff will deal with the situation. Other than ringing staff for support, mobile phones MUST NOT be used. Please DO NOT expect to be in contact with your child whilst they are on expedition. We will post updates on our Twitter feed and your child will be allowed to ring you once they have finished their expedition.
