A number of subjects are offering "Supercram" sessions on particular weekends before a public examination in that subject. While the sessions are not compulsory, we strongly advise that you consider these opportunities and, where possible, encourage your child to attend.

The sessions will cover crucial tips for revision, as well as support students in the revision they do at home. They will provide students with the chance to re-align their revision, gain additional revision resources and 'talk to the experts' during the holiday period.

It should be noted that attending these sessions must be supplementary to your child's own revision efforts which they will need to dedicate extensive time to over the Easter and May Half Term holidays.

Sessions which are under allocation (fewer than 10 students) will be cancelled by Friday 28th March and families will be notified. In addition, any session which is oversubscribed for the number of staff available we may need to allocate places on a lottery basis, which again will be confirmed via communications directly to you.
